

# AND NOW, WHAT? 1<sup>st</sup> Workshop for students who are thinking about their future Granada, 13<sup>th</sup> May 2015

## AIMS

We have decided to create a workshop in which students will present different options of what to do after university (in the near future):

- ✓ Continuing university studies (masters'; PhD; etc.)
- ✓ Starting a professional career (as a civil engineer)
- ✓ Breaking all their previous plan. Finding new paths

It will be interactive. Therefore, it will be absolutely necessary to put our soft skills to work (communication, adaptability, problem-solving, strong work ethic, team working, negotiation and emotional intelligence)

## DEVELOPMENT

Over the next two months students will be working on their assigned option in small groups. They will spend approximately eight hours:

- ✓ Planning their roles
- ✓ Researching and studying documents
- ✓ Developing a multimedia presentation

On the day of the workshop and after a brief presentation by the hosts (introductions, goals and methodology), students will give their presentation trying to persuade the audience that their option is the only way forward. After a coffee-break there will be time for debate, feedback from the hosts and elaborate "take away". The workshop will last 3 hours, from 16:30 to 19:30.
